CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: Otterbein returns home for the final game of the year, looking to withstand some close defeats and still salvage a 5-5 season. The Cardinals are coming off a pair of tough outings against top-ranked Mount Union and #16 John Carroll, but should feel ready to go one last time in front of their home crowd.

A LOOK AT MARIETTA: The Pioneers have slowly, but surely, gotten better under fourth-year head coach Andy Waddle and a fourth win today would give the program its most victories since the 2006 season. Marietta already holds exciting wins over Baldwin Wallace, 62-56, and Capital, 27-21, to gain some momentum in the second half of the year. The Pios are 0-4 on the road this year.

RECENT MEETINGS: Otterbein has won four-straight matchups over the Pioneers, most recently earning a 31-21 victory last year after a defensive TD put the game away. The last Marietta victory came in 2011, a 30-27 decision after a last-second field goal.

BE THE MATCH: Both football programs joined forces this week with "Be The Match" to host respective Bone Marrow Registry Drives on their campuses. The "Save a Friend Challenge" is geared towards helping DiMante Burrough, a former teammate of Pioneer QB Darrien Fields, who was diagnosed with leukemia last year. His best chance of a cure is receiving a bone marrow or stem-cell transplant.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "They are a team with athletes everywhere and big guys up front, on both sides of the ball," head coach Tim Doup said. "Their program is gaining steam behind a lot of younger players and playing very well right now. It may be Senior Day for us, but this game means a ton to Marietta as well. Another win pushes them into the offseason with momentum as they try to move up the OAC ranks. It's going to be a great battle."

SENIOR CITIZENS: Otterbein will be recognizing 11 members of its senior class during pregame for their contributions to the program. Players include (in numerical order) Anthony Wene, Dalton Jarvis, Will McCollister, Joe Iafelice, Tyler Cook, Joe Batey, Nick Toledo, Jalen Liggins, Steve Clum, Justin Henry and P.J. Svigel.

STEPP OUTSIDE: Junior Logan Stepp has enjoyed a solid year at QB after transitioning from wide receiver in the offseason, currently leading the conference with 267 yards of total offense per game. His 21 total TD's puts him third in the league, one back of the top spot, and he will need 305 yards through the air today to become just the fourth-different Otterbein player in the last 20 years to throw for 2,000 yards in a season.

AYE AYE, CAPTAIN: Seniors Dalton Jarvis, defensive end, and Justin Henry, offensive line, will walk out to midfield as team captains one final time on Saturday. Jarvis opened his year by representing the Cards at OAC Media Day, while Henry has started every contest at right guard.

ROGER THAT: The Cardinal defense will have a tough task in slowing down Marietta running back Roger Walker, who leads the OAC with 174 rushing attempts and sits third at 123.7 yards per game. He has 10 touchdowns on the ground and is also the team's third-leading receiver with 269 yards and another three TD's.
