CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: The Cardinals, coming off a 4-6 season after three-straight years of .500 or better, travel out of state and look to get revenge in the rematch of a home-and-home series with Buffalo State. The Bengals won 29-0 last year in Westerville.

A LOOK AT THE BENGALS: Buffalo State, competing in the Empire 8 conference, has won a combined 15 games over the past two years after going 8-3 in 2014 and 7-4 a year ago. The Bengals, who last endured a losing season in 2010, went a perfect 5-0 at home last fall but graduated 18 senior starters, including 10 from the defense. Buffalo State has an enrollment of 11,000 and its football roster consists almost entirely of in-state talent.

GAME NOTES (CONT. ON NEXT PAGE)

OHIO vs. NEW YORK: Both Otterbein and Buffalo State have rosters that consist almost entirely of in-state players. The Cardinals have just five players from outside of Ohio while the Bengals' breakdown also includes just four kids from beyond the New York state border.

NUMBER 5: Coaches selected senior defensive end Dalton Jarvis to wear #5 this season. The number is awarded to a player who best demonstrates commitment, leadership, and work ethic in honor of Josh Worthington, a promising quarterback, who wore #5 but lost his life in a car accident back in 2004. Jarvis has played wherever necessary during his career, beginning as a fullback, switching to defensive end and even playing nose guard last fall when the team needed production inside.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "They are a big and physical team," Otterbein head coach Tim Doup said of the Bengals. "We obviously need to stop the run but can't get lulled to sleep and let a big pass over the top. Each guy will need to do his one job, out of 11, and help continue an atmosphere of focus and accountability. It will be a business trip."

GAME NOTES CONT..

STEPP BY STEPP: Junior Logan Stepp, one of the team's leading receivers in 2014 and 2015, made the transition to QB in the offseason and then won the starting job coming out of preseason camp. An All-Ohio signal caller in high school, Stepp is a true athlete that hauled in three receiving TD's and averaged 12.4 yards per catch last fall.

TRANSFERABLE SKILLS: A handful of transfers are expected to serve as offensive weapons right away. Wide receivers Hunter Joseph, Fred Hardgrove and Prince Franklin II can all be dangerous while running back Isaiah Richmond brings a nice element to the backfield. Richmond has high expectations after transferring in from Eastern Kentucky, where he played linebacker.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Those offensive skill players aren't the only new faces ready to contribute right away. DE Justin Harris, DB Dassan Jefferson and LB Tony Bishop have cracked the first two-deep on defense while QB Jackson Klein and offensive linemen Winston Spiker and Austin Wallace look to provide depth on the other side as backups. In addition, freshman Luke Green-Lauber may be called upon in the kicking game.

SLOT MACHINE: Slot receiver Julian Lowe had an impressive 2015 campaign, ranking second in the league for receptions (77), receiving yards (861) and receiving TD's (12) to warrant first team All-OAC honors. Lowe also set a new OAC record in the 200-meter dash (22.19) during indoor track and field season back in late February.

SAME FACES, NEW PLACES: Senior Joe Batey and redshirt sophomore Dakota "Boobie" Smith, both offensive players a year ago, have transitioned across the line of scrimmage to play outside linebacker this season. Batey was a wide receiver while Smith initially began in the secondary, then moved to running back and has now returned to defense.

A GOOD CHRISTIAN: Sophomore RB Christian Johnson is primed to help shoulder a load of carries after learning the ropes in his inaugural season. He added 10 pounds of muscle in the offseason and could also be back to return some kicks on special teams.

START SOMETHING: Otterbein won five-straight season openers from 2008-12 but has since dropped the last three, falling twice to nationally-ranked St. John Fisher and then last year to Buffalo State, which competes in the same conference as SJF.

VICTORY LAP: Fifth-year DB Jalen Liggins, suffering a season-ending injury a few games into last season, exercised a medical redshirt and will have one final go-around in 2016. He made a career-high nine tackles at Heidelberg last fall, the game he went down in.
