CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: The Cardinals look to rebound in the conference opener after a disappointing 29-26 loss at Buffalo State, surrendering 15-unanswered points in the fourth quarter.

A LOOK AT THE QUAKERS: Wilmington, 1-29 over the past three years, defeated Bluffton in its 2015 season opener but recently dropped a 49-20 decision in the rematch with the Beavers two weeks ago. Fourth-year head coach Stacey Hairston was a standout DB at Ohio Northern in his college days, eventually playing for the Cleveland Browns from 1993-95. He was also ONU's interim head coach in 2003, leading the Polar Bears to a 4-6 record.

GAME NOTES (CONT. ON NEXT PAGE)

THE LEAGUE: After a five-hour trip to Buffalo State, the Cardinals are ready to turn their attention towards the Ohio Athletic Conference schedule. Otterbein has won four-straight OAC openers, beating Marietta twice and Wilmington twice. The last defeat came in 2011, a narrow 34-33 overtime loss to Ohio Northern.

ANDY MAN: Second-year offensive line/special teams coach Andy Fries will be back in some familiar territory Saturday night after spending the 2013 and 2014 seasons as an assistant for Wilmington. A 2009 graduate of Otterbein, Fries was an All-American offensive lineman for the Cards who helped captain the 2008 playoff team. He also earned his master's from Otterbein, in 2012, while working as a graduate assistant.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "You're going to see two very pumped-up teams," Otterbein head coach Tim Doup said. "It's their first home game of the season, under the lights, while we are eager to get back out there after a disappointing loss. They have some good team speed and do a few things on defense that can cause problems with coverage and blitzes, and they also have a new offensive coordinator. We are preparing for anything."

GAME NOTES CONT...

SEEING GREEN: Otterbein will see plenty of Wilmington's color green come Saturday night, but the Cards also saw former QB Kevan Green, who wasn't known as a running threat, scamper for 103 yards last season against the Quakers. (Green's second-best rushing total was just 17 yards). Otterbein now features a dual-threat behind center.

ONE STEPP AT A TIME: Junior Logan Stepp turned some heads in his first game at QB since converting from WR in the offseason, accounting for 298 total yards (210 passing, 88 rushing) and three total touchdowns at Buffalo State. The first time Stepp ever touched the ball in a varsity game came in 2014, as a freshman, when he took a slant pass 80 yards for a touchdown at Wilmington.

HUNGRY AS A HUNTER: Junior wide receiver Hunter Joseph had a nice debut at Buffalo State after transferring from Ohio Dominican, catching seven passes for 145 yards and a touchdown. He hauled in a 50-yard score from Stepp midway through the third quarter to run Otterbein's lead to 19-7 at the time.

EVEN STEVEN: Junior safety Steven Carpenter, voted one of four team captains in the preseason, finished second on the team in tackles last fall and recently tied for a game-high nine at Buffalo State. Carpenter, who played junior varsity in 2013 and then missed the entire 2014 season while away at basic training for the Army National Guard, will be featured by the Columbus Dispatch next Tuesday for its 'Central Ohio Watch.'

SAFETY FIRST: Otterbein tallied its first safety since Nov. 9, 2013 last weekend at Buffalo State, watching defensive backs Jalen Liggins and Melvin Medina swarm the Bengals' punter in the end zone early in the second quarter. The play put the Cards up 9-7.

EXTRA CREDIT: The Otterbein defense will certainly see its fair share of Wilmington quarterback Luke Credit, who completed 20 of 32 passes for 198 yards in his opener and also rushed 13 times for 45 yards ... most of that coming on a 42-yard TD scamper. Credit was responsible for 216 yards of offense last season against the Cardinals.

UP NEXT: After two road affairs and a bye week, Otterbein will finally host its first game of the 2016 season at Memorial Stadium next Saturday, welcoming Ohio Northern for kickoff at 1:30 p.m.
