CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: The Cardinals will finally host their home opener after two road games sandwiched around a bye week, looking to snap a three-game losing streak against Ohio Northern. The Polar Bears have taken nine of the past 12 matchups overall, including a 42-10 triumph last year in Ada.



A LOOK AT THE POLAR BEARS: ONU, ranked 18th-nationally in the preseason poll, has gotten off to an unusual 0-2 start after a 34-30 loss to Utica and then a 45-14 defeat at Heidelberg last Saturday. The Polar Bears, who made the second round of the NCAA playoffs last fall, led 30-13 at Utica midway through the fourth quarter before the Pioneers scored 21 straight to finish. Included in the rally was an 83-yard interception return for a touchdown.

STRONG START: The 52-7 rout at Wilmington gave Otterbein a win in its OAC opener for a fifth-straight season. The last loss to begin conference play for the Cards came in 2011, a 34-33 overtime loss against Ohio Northern.

AUSTIN POWER: Last weekend's outing marked the anticipated return of 2x All-OAC linebacker Austin Jones, who went down on the very first play of last season's opener against Buffalo State with a torn ACL and fractured tibia. Jones, now a redshirt junior, totaled 196 tackles over his first two seasons and eased back into action with a limited snap count at Wilmington.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "We fully expect to get their best shot this week, and then some," Otterbein head coach Tim Doup said of Ohio Northern. "They were in total control against Utica and heading down the field to put the finishing touches on, and it just slipped away. Then they had a tough assignment in the first night game ever played at Heidelberg. It's not your typical 0-2 football team. They are big, physical, well-coached and will surely be ready to go."

GAME NOTES CONT...

STONE COLD: Sophomore running back Justin Stoner, getting the first start of his career, just missed the century mark at Wilmington by carrying 15 times for 99 yards and a touchdown. He turned in a workmanlike effort, with just a long of 15 yards, and pushed Otterbein's lead to 28-0 early in the second quarter with his one-yard score.

SHAQ ATTACK: Sophomore running back Shaq Alexander also had a nice debut for the Cardinals at Wilmington, averaging a healthy 9.6 yards per carry with 86 on just nine attempts. The 6-1, 210-pound ball carrier busted a 34-yard TD run to open the second-half scoring.

CUP OF JOE: Senior Joe Batey, playing his first season at outside linebacker after making the switch from wide receiver, came up with his first-career interception early in the second quarter at Wilmington. Batey is tied for second on the team so far with nine stops and has also a forced fumble.

RUSH HOUR(S): The Cards dominated the rushing category, on both sides, during the few hours of competition at Wilmington. Otterbein finished with a lopsided 359-13 advantage on the ground, with Stoner, Alexander and fellow sophomore Steven Irwin all posting 86 or more yards.

WILL-I-AM: Otterbein's defense will be forced to contain Polar Bear quarterback Will Freed, who started ONU's first six games last year as a freshman before an injury kept him out until the playoffs. The California native broke ONU's single-game passing record with 439 yards in his collegiate debut but has also thrown nine INT's in nine-career games. Oddly enough, three of those came in a 30-27 win at No. 11-ranked John Carroll.

THIRD TIME'S A CHARM: Saturday's outcome could certainly be decided on third downs. Otterbein has converted 48 percent of its chances on offense this season while the Ohio Northern defense is allowing the chains to be moved 54 percent of the time.

UP NEXT: Otterbein will stay at home next weekend as well, hosting cross-town rival Capital at 2 p.m. as part of Homecoming weekend. The Cards have beaten Capital four-straight times, including a 49-34 triumph last season during a testy and emotional contest in Bexley.
