CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: Otterbein and Heidelberg get set to play in the 25th matchup for the Rhine River Cup. The Cards got back into the win column last week and will now try and snap a five-game losing skid to the Student Princes, who won an entertaining 49-31 showdown last year in Tiffin.

A LOOK AT THE STUDENT PRINCES: The Berg' has opened with a very challenging stretch, playing the always formidable Cortland State before tough outings against John Carroll and Mount Union. Heidelberg is led by first-year head coach Scott Donaldson, who took over this fall after 12 seasons as an assistant, and last five as defensive coordinator. The Student Princes can hit the big play, scoring 25.6 ppg. but ranking last in the OAC in time of possession (24:13).

DOWN BY THE RIVER: Otterbein and Heidelberg took part in the first-ever collegiate football game played in Germany during the 1992 season, which ended in a 7-7 tie. The teams have been playing for the Rhine River Cup ever since, with the Cardinals holding a 13-10-1 advantage.

GIVE ME FIVE: Otterbein may have won more meetings since 1992, but the Rhine River Cup has resided at Heidelberg for the past five years. The Cards led 21-12 towards the end of the first half last year in Tiffin, but the Student Princes scored a pair of TD's in the final two minutes before intermission and then ultimately rolled to a 49-31 triumph.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "“Their offensive line is very good and Lacey is a great running back, so don't let their rushing numbers fool you,” head coach Tim Doup said. “If you look at recent meetings, we haven't done a good job of stopping their run game. I think they'll want to establish things on the ground and then let Stoye perform as he does. They can be very balanced if or when they need to be.”

GAME NOTES CONT...

I WANNA BE RICH: Running back Isaiah Richmond continues to find his form after recovering from a preseason injury, rushing 12 times for 109 yards and a game-clinching touchdown last weekend at Muskingum. He is averaging nine yards per carry and forms a nice duo with sophomore Christian Johnson.

DON'T BE COY: Slot receiver Payton Vanderkooi has shown some nice flashes as of late, leading the team in receiving over the past two games after increased opportunities. He had a combined seven catches for 137 yards against Capital and Muskingum.

PICK UP STEAM: Defensive back Jalen Liggins snagged his first-career INT in the win at Muskingum, running down a pass up the sidelines in the third quarter to give the Cards possession after they turned it over on the previous play. He also made a season-high eight tackles against the Muskies and continues to be Otterbein's best cover corner.

POINTS OF VIEW: The last three matchups between Otterbein and Heidelberg have been high-scoring, with the Student Princes winning by scores of 49-31, 45-28 and 35-17. Otterbein is averaging almost 32 points per game this fall but will need to slow down the Heidelberg attack.

EAT CROW: Otterbein's offensive line will have its hands full this week with Heidelberg defensive lineman Austin Crow, who leads all of NCAA Division III with 17 tackles for loss. A Westerville native, Crow returns to his hometown Saturday after recently being selected to the D3football.com National Team of the Week.

STOYLE/DOUP CONNECTION: Otterbein head coach Tim Doup and Heidelberg QB Tyler Stoye have a unique connection, with Doup and Stoye's father, Jim, being close friends for a long time. Both Doup and Jim Stoye were groomsmen in each other's weddings and Doup has known Tyler Stoye since he was a little boy.

DEAD GIVEAWAY: Turnovers have really hurt the Cardinals in both home games this fall, losing three fumbles against Ohio Northern and then another three against Capital. Otterbein finished +1 in the turnover margin last year at Heidelberg, throwing one pick but forcing and recovering a pair of Student Prince fumbles.

UP NEXT: Otterbein heads back on the road to take on Baldwin Wallace next Saturday in Berea. The Cards had won three-straight games over BW until the Yellow Jackets posted a one-sided 55-21 victory last year in Westerville.
