# CARDINAL FOOTBALL

**THIS WEEK:** Otterbein looks to keep its momentum and notch a third-straight win after falling to Baldwin Wallace last year. Otterbein had defeated the Yellow Jackets three-straight times before BW earned a 55-21 victory in 2015. The Cards are 2-1 in road game this year, the only loss being a narrow 29-26 decision at Buffalo State.

**VS.**



**A LOOK AT THE YELLOW JACKETS:** BW, led by 15th-year head coach John Snell, went 7-3 last year but are off to a slow start this season. The Yellow Jackets have dropped one-possession games with John Carroll, Marietta and, most recently, Muskingum. BW is 1-1 on its home turf this fall, routing Defiance 42-0 and then dropping a 49-7 contest with top-ranked Mount Union, a game that was tied 7-7 midway through the second quarter.

## GAME NOTES (CONT. ON NEXT PAGE)

**BOOMIN' IN BERE:** Otterbein has fared rather well in Berea since 2009 by winning three of four matchups, with the only loss being a 35-34 decision in which BW scored in the closing minutes. The Cards prevailed 20-9 in their most recent visit, in 2014, after scoring a pair of fourth-quarter touchdowns.

**OH DANNY BOY:** Otterbein offensive coordinator Dan Damico is a 2009 graduate of Baldwin Wallace, where he was a four-year letterman at wide receiver. The Cards rank second in the OAC with 34 points per game this season under the guidance of Damico, who also coaches quarterbacks.

**WHAT TO EXPECT:** "They returned a lot of guys on offense and have a sophomore quarterback coming into his own, both running and throwing," head coach Tim Doup said. "They are a mature team and, similar to us, just haven't had some things go their way in close games. I expect Baldwin Wallace to be wound up and ready to go on their Homecoming weekend. Both teams really need this game, so we'll see what the fourth quarter brings."

## GAME NOTES CONT...

**JESUS, MARY AND JOSEPH!** Wide receiver Hunter Joseph, missing the Muskingum game with an injury, returned with a bang last weekend against Heidelberg with six catches for 221 yards and a pair of touchdowns, both coming in the third quarter to help Otterbein take the lead for good. Joseph's 221 receiving yards were the most in a game since 2004 when Ricardo Lenhart had 240, also coming against Heidelberg.

**STEPP ON THE GAS:** Quarterback Logan Stepp is coming off his best game of the fall, setting a new Otterbein single-game record with 477 total yards of offense (365 passing, 112 rushing) against Heidelberg. The reigning OAC Offensive Player of the Week, he leads the entire conference with 18 touchdowns.

**KEEP UP WITH THE JONESES:** 2x All-OAC linebacker Austin Jones, who missed all of last season with an injury, seems to have regained his old form after leading the defense with 12 tackles in the Heidelberg win. He fully returned on Sept. 24 against ONU and now has at least one tackle for a loss in each of the past three outings.

**MAY THE FOURTH BE WITH YOU:** Many games are decided in the fourth quarter, but that may be especially true for Saturday's contest as both teams are getting outscored in the final period. Otterbein has outscored the opposition 161-92 through the first-three quarters but is slightly behind, 57-43, in the fourth. BW is outscoring opponents in each quarter as well until the fourth, where its opposition holds a 58-36 edge.

**RUNNING ON FUMES:** Opponents have struggled to run against the Cardinal defense this year, with Otterbein ranking third in the league by allowing just 100.3 per game on the ground. Only Buffalo State, in the season opener, has surpassed 130 yards.

**TAKE YOUR PICK:** Baldwin Wallace has thrown nine interceptions this year compared to just one for Otterbein, but the Yellow Jackets have also been opportunistic by picking off eight passes defensively. The Cards have fine interceptions, with senior DB Jalen Liggins have one in each of the past two games.

**TWO-HEADED MONSTER:** The Baldwin Wallace defense has been led this year by the linebacker duo of Brian Stepp and Sam Groff, who have 54 and 53 tackles, respectively.

**UP NEXT:** Otterbein returns home to test its fate against Mount Union, the nation's top-ranked team and defending national champion. The Purple Raiders have won 24-straight Ohio Athletic Conference championships.
