CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: Otterbein returns home off a third-straight win and now plays host to top-ranked and defending national champion Mount Union. The Cards have three one-possession results at home this year, recently defeating Heidelberg, 45-38, after narrow losses to Capital and Ohio Northern. Otterbein is looking to reach five wins for the ninth time in the last 13 years.

A LOOK AT MOUNT UNION: The Purple Raiders, led by fourth-year head coach Vince Kehres, hold a 110-game regular-season win streak and are 220-1 in the regular season dating back to 1994. The only loss came in 2005 when visiting Ohio Northern won 21-14 in Alliance. Mount Union has won 24-straight OAC titles and captured its 12th national championship to finish off last year. The group returned seven starters on offense and two on defense this fall.

REVENGE OF THE BIRDS: Otterbein tallied a pair of revenge victories the past two weeks, overcoming 2015 losses to Heidelberg and Baldwin Wallace. The Cardinals racked up 579 yards of total offense against Heidelberg and then pulled out a 33-30 triumph at BW last Saturday behind another 408 yards.

PURPLE PEOPLE: Otterbein currently has four Mount Union alums employed on the athletic staff in Dara Ford (cross country/track & field head coach), Adam Prescott (sports information director), David Smith (running backs coach) and Jon Garrison (wrestling graduate assistant).

WHAT TO EXPECT: "You have to limit big plays against Mount Union," head coach Tim Doup said. "You can't give up a kickoff return, let a punt get blocked or surrender quick scores. It's much easier said than done, but you just have to curb momentum and stay mentally stable throughout. If you start panicking, then things begin to snowball and you lose all control."

GAME NOTES CONT...

DIAL UP KYLE: Junior defense end Kyle Blust earned OAC 'Defensive Player of the Week' honors after an impressive outing at Baldwin Wallace. Playing with strep throat, Blust tied for a game-high 10 tackles (four for loss) and registered his seventh sack of the season. He now ranks 12th-nationally with 14.5 tackles for a loss.

FRESH PRINCE: Sophomore Prince Franklin II was solid in his college debut at defensive back last week, making nine tackles in the win at Baldwin Wallace and battling down the field in coverage. He just recently made the switch to defense after spending the first half of the season as a slot receiver.

MASTERS OF THE UNIVERSE: Redshirt sophomore linebacker Steven Masters, who missed last season due to injury, grabbed his first-career interception during the second quarter at Baldwin Wallace. The Yellow Jackets had just crossed into Otterbein territory before Masters stepped in front of a pass and returned it 17 yards.

LOWE-KEY: Junior slot receiver Julian Lowe, a returning first team All-OAC selection, has now caught a TD in four-straight games after seven grabs for 92 yards and a score at Baldwin Wallace. The OAC indoor champion in the 200-meter dash, Lowe also returns kicks and punts for the Cardinals.

FREESTYLE FRED: Versatile freshman wide receiver Fred Hardgrove contributed on both sides of the ball last weekend, also getting some reps at SPUR linebacker against BW. He made one tackle, broke up a pass and affected a handful of other plays.

TOSS AND TURN: Mount Union is a staggering 7-0 in coin tosses this year, choosing to defer in every instance and take the ball to begin the second half. Otterbein is 4-3 in the pregame toss, deferring all four times as well.

IN THE TRENCHES: Otterbein features Kyle Blust and senior captain Dalton Jarvis as defensive ends, but Mount Union boasts a veteran offensive line with two seniors and three juniors. Leading the bunch is All-American Mitch Doraty, who was awarded the Rimington Trophy last year as the top center in NCAA Division III.

UP NEXT: Otterbein gets back on the bus for its final road game of the season, traveling to play nationally-ranked John Carroll inside Don Shula Stadium at 1:30 p.m.
