CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: Otterbein hits the road for its final away game of 2016, traveling to take on its second-straight nationally-ranked opponent. John Carroll has been ranked in each of the past three matchups against the Cards, sitting sixth in 2014 and 15th this time last fall. The Cardinals are 3-1 on the road this year.

A LOOK AT JOHN CARROLL: The Blue Streaks, led by fourth-year head coach Tom Arth, have gone a perfect 7-0 since their season-opening loss at No. 5-ranked UW-Oshkosh and are 23-4 in OAC play under Arth, with three of those losses coming to Mount Union. JCU made back-to-back playoff appearances before just missing out last year. Included in their recent postseason adventures was a 2014 quarterfinal loss (36-28) at Mount Union.

GAME NOTES (CONT. ON NEXT PAGE)

RECENT MEETINGS: Otterbein defeated John Carroll, 21-7, during head coach Tim Doup's first season back in 2012, but the Blue Streaks have taken the past three in the series. Otterbein trailed just 21-13 at halftime last fall before JCU rattled off three-straight TD's in the second half.

ROAD RAGE: The Cards have turned up the intensity on the road this year, going 3-1 away from home and averaging more than 35 ppg. in those contests. Otterbein's lone road defeat came in the 29-26 season-opener at Buffalo State, a game the Cardinals led 26-14 in the fourth quarter.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "Everyone has to focus on doing their job and helping us throw some things at John Carroll," head coach Tim Doup said. "They have one of the best defenses in the country and will provide some big challenges. We can't just line up and run it at them twice, and then find ourselves in third-and-long. It will be important to stay as balanced as we can and then go from there."

GAME NOTES CONT...

GROUND RULES: John Carroll and Otterbein have achieved success on the ground this year, currently ranking second and third, respectively, in the OAC for total rushing yards, yards per game and yards per attempt. However, the Blue Streak defense only allows 68.4 yards rushing per week.

THIRD WORLD: Otterbein and John Carroll have produced different results in third-down defense, with the Cards allowing 53% conversion and the Blue Streaks ranking third in the entire country by only surrendering a 22% success rate. JCU was 8 of 13 in last year's matchup while Otterbein converted just 3 of 12 opportunities.

WIDE AWAKE: The Cardinal offense has remained alive on the perimeter throughout the season, with wide receivers Julian Lowe and Hunter Joseph both ranking top-5 in the OAC for receiving yards and touchdowns. Lowe sits second in the conference with 44 catches while Joseph is second in receiving yards (631) despite missing a game.

UP NEXT: Otterbein returns home and plays host to Marietta in the season finale, which will also be Senior Day for the program. Kickoff is scheduled for 1:30 p.m.
