CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: Otterbein launches the 2017 season with its only non-league game of the fall, traveling to nearby Ohio Wesleyan for a showdown under the lights. The schools have scrimmaged one another in recent years but last played a regular-season contest in 1989, despite being just 17 miles apart.



A LOOK AT OWU: The Battling Bishops have posted five-straight winning seasons under head coach Tom Watts, who took over in 2012 and immediately led the team to a 9-1 campaign. Ohio Wesleyan was picked to finish fifth in the NCAC preseason poll this year, and is 15-10 at home since Watts arrived. OWU played at eventual national champion Mary Hardin-Baylor to begin last season, falling by a score of 56-0.

UPPER CLASS: Otterbein will feature a very experienced group this fall, with the initial two-deep chsart featuring 32 players in either their third, fourth or fifth year of college football. The offense will start eight seniors, two juniors and one sophomore out of the gate.

OPEN FOR BUSINESS: The Cardinals are looking to win their season-opener for the first time since 2012 after dropping challenging home-and-home matchups with St. John Fisher and Buffalo State from 2013-16. Otterbein led for most of the way last year in Buffalo before the host Bengals stormed back with 15 points in the final seven minutes, escaping with a 29-26 win.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "We have to do whatever it takes to come out of this game 1-0," Doup said. "The fact is that we haven't won a non-conference game in four years, and that needs to change so we finally get a boost. But I'm sure Ohio Wesleyan is saying the same thing after playing Mary Hardin-Baylor the past two years. It will be a physical game and we will need to be ready."

GAME NOTES CONT...

NIGHT RIDERS: Otterbein is 6-0 in night games over the last three seasons, including a 52-7 rout at Wilmington and then a 45-38 triumph over Heidelberg last season. The Cards had a combined 1,105 yards of total offense in those two outings.

STEPP ON IT: Senior quarterback Logan Stepp will have the reins once again after first team All-OAC honors last year, leading the league in total offense per game (268.7) and finishing second with 25 TD's. He completed 60% of his passes for 1,917 yards and just three interceptions, while also scampering for another 770 yards on the ground.

HUDDLE UP: Otterbein's second-year graduate assistant James Huddleston will be in familiar territory, graduating from Ohio Wesleyan in 2013 after a decorated stint with the Bishops. A powerful defensive end, he was the NCAC 'Newcomer of the Year' as a freshman before earning three-straight first team All-NCAC awards. Huddleston was the 2011 NCAA statistical champion with 23.5 tackles for loss, and then captained the OWU's 2012 conference championship team.

CATCH YOU ON THE FLIP SIDE: Otterbein's All-OAC kicker Joe Sanfillipo will enjoy some sibling rivalry as older brother, Anthony, is expected to take over the kicking duties for Ohio Wesleyan this season. Joe finished 12th in the conference with 60 points last year, averaged 40 yards per punt and nailed a career-long 47-yarder field goal.

MANY HAPPY RETURNS: Special teams and field position will surely be critical. Ohio Wesleyan averaged 23.8 yards per kickoff return last fall (third-best in the NCAC) while Otterbein mustered just a 16.4 average as a group. The Cards will have a dangerous duo back to receive kicks this fall in senior wideouts Julian Lowe and Hunter Joseph.

ALL WHITE EVERYTHING: Otterbein will be wearing brand new road uniforms this year, consisting of all white Nike helmets, jerseys and pants.

STRENGTH ON STRENGTH: The Cardinals posted 30 points per game last year and has all weapons back for another go-around, but the Ohio Wesleyan defense surrendered just 22.1 per game in 2016 to rank fourth in the NCAC.

UP NEXT: Unlike past seasons, Otterbein will not have a bye in week two and instead host Muskingum next Saturday in the home opener at Memorial Stadium. Kickoff is scheduled for 1:30 p.m. as it will be the only Ohio Athletic Conference game of the
