CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: Otterbein plays its first home game of the year after opening the season with a 36-15 triumph at Ohio Wesleyan. The Cards have gone 14-12 at Memorial Stadium under head coach Tim Doup and have beaten the Muskies 13-straight times.

A LOOK AT MUSKINGUM: The Muskies, under the guidance of 11th-year head coach Al Logan, posted a 19-0 shutout victory over Waynesburg in its season-opener last week at home. Muskingum went 4-6 a year ago and returned 18 of 22 starters this season ... eight on offense and 10 for the defense. The squad is replacing All-American linebacker Chaney Fulton, but limited Waynesburg to just 114 yards of total offense last Saturday.

CLOSER THAN YOU THINK: Despite Otterbein having won 13-straight games in this series, it never seems to be easy and typically comes down to the fourth quarter. Each of the past six matchups have been decided by 13 points or less, including a trio of one-possession games. The Cards have won five-straight conference openers.

GIMME' THAT PIGSKIN: The new-look Otterbein secondary was on full display in week one, coming up with four interceptions after making six all of last season. The Cardinal defense forced five Ohio Wesleyan turnovers as a unit, almost half of the 11 takeaways from 2016.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "The physicality will be the same as always," Doup said of facing Muskingum. "Their defensive line is big, moves well and spearheads an aggressive unit. They won't do a lot fancy, but they are very good at what they do and absolutely know who they are. They are coming off a big win and I expect a slugfest once again."

GAME NOTES CONT...

FREESTYLE FRED: Sophomore Fred Hardgrove was impressive during his debut at free safety, making seven tackles and picking off two passes. He started his career as a wide receiver before switching to a coverage linebacker in the latter stages of last season, and is now settling in on the backend.

TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE: Otterbein held the ball for nearly two-thirds of the entire game last week at OWU, posting a final 39:53 time of possession that include some lengthy drives. The Cards had an almost even time of possession throughout last fall.

YES, MASTER: Junior linebacker Steven Masters delivered a strong performance in the opener, compiling five tackles (3.5 for loss) to go along with two sacks and a forced fumble. He started three games and played in all 10 last season, but now appears ready for the next step in his career.

BUY LOWE, SELL HIGH: Senior wideout Julian Lowe was his usual self to launch the season, posting game-highs of nine catches and 147 yards to help the offense. He needs nine more touchdown receptions to match the Otterbein all-time record of 29.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Freshman defensive back Brandon Paschal and fifth-year senior Chris Bivins were solid in their inaugural games for the Tan and Cardinal. Paschal made a team-high 10 stops against OWU while Bivins, a D-1 transfer, had a few tackles and an interception on limited snaps. In addition, newbie Austin Corry earned the start at nose guard and registered three tackles in the trenches.

WECKING BALL: Muskingum defensive end Chris Weck was a force in week one against Waynesburg, earning OAC 'Defensive Player of the Week' honors after nine tackles (3 for loss), one sack, one interception and one pass breakup. He will looking to corral Otterbein QB Logan Stepp, who is the reigning OAC 'Offensive Player of the Week.'

THIRD TIME'S A CHARM: Both teams had very different outputs on third down in their week-one contests. The Cardinals converted 9 of 14 (64%) opportunities while the Muskies struggled in going just 1 of 14.

UP NEXT: Otterbein will stay at home throughout the next week, ultimately hosting Wilmington College as part of Homecoming on the 16th. The Cardinals topped the Quakers, 52-7, last year on the road.
