CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: Otterbein stays at home for the second week in a row, looking to post another Homecoming victory over Wilmington after defeating the Quakers 31-9 back in 2015. The Cards have won 10-straight matchups between the two schools.

A LOOK AT WILMINGTON: The Quakers have begun a new era under first-year head coach Bryan Moore, snapping a 19-game losing streak in their first contest with a 49-20 win over Earlham. Freshman Parris Weathersby was the OAC 'Special Teams Player of the Week' following that game by making tackles on six of the team's eight kickoffs. Wilmington has 24 players from outside of Ohio, half of those by way of Florida.

GAME NOTES (CONT. ON NEXT PAGE)

DECADE OF DOMINANCE: Otterbein has topped Wilmington in 10-straight meetings, outscoring the Quakers by an average of 25.5 points per game in the stretch. The Cards posted a 52-7 road win last year behind a 526-219 advantage in total offense.

FIRST IMPRESSION: The Cards ignited the home crowd on the first play from scrimmage in week two against Muskingum, connecting on a 55-yard TD pass from quarterback Logan Stepp to wide receiver Hunter Joseph.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "They will be very well-coached," Doup said when asked about Wilmington. "Bryan and some of his assistants were at Heidelberg when they got that thing turned around. I'm sure we will see a new team that is different on both sides of the ball. They have a veteran quarterback and other athletes around him. We will need to take care of the little things and stay focused."

GAME NOTES CONT...

HUNTING GROUND: Senior wideout Hunter Joseph was named the OAC 'Offensive Player of the Week' on Monday after an impressive outing against Muskingum. Joseph had six catches for 171 yards and three TD's in the first half, then added a 10-yard grab in the third quarter before resting most of the fourth.

LEARN THE HARD WAY: Sophomore safety Fred Hardgrove continues getting acclimated to his position in the secondary, most recently tallying a career-best 16 tackles (10 solo) against the Muskies. Hardgrove, who has 23 tackles and two interceptions so far, switched from wide receiver to coverage linebacker in the latter portion of last season before now making the change to the defensive backfield. He is the reigning OAC 'Defensive Player of the Week.'

ANDY MAN: Third-year special teams coordinator and offensive line coach Andy Fries has ties to this week's opponent, spending the 2013 and 2014 seasons on the Quaker staff. A 2009 graduate of Otterbein, Fries was an All-American offensive lineman who helped captain the 2008 playoff team. He allowed just one sack in his entire career.

GET OFF MY LAWN: The Otterbein defense found a way to escape from some red zone situations against Muskingum, recovering a fumble on the goal line and also coming up with a key interception inside the 5-yard line.

RUN AROUND: Otterbein is looking to establish its running game a bit more effectively. The Cards are averaging an even 4.0 yards per carry through two weeks, although the number was a bit inflated last Saturday following a 76-yard rushing score from QB Logan Stepp.

CHECK YOUR CREDITT: The Cardinal defense will be looking to contain Wilmington quarterback Luke Creditt, a three-year starter who accounted for 383 yards of offense in his opening week. He had two passing touchdowns and scored another on the ground.

MOORE POWER TO YOU: Wilmington features a new head coach this season in Bryan Moore, who spent the past three seasons as offensive coordinator at Bluffton. Prior to that, he was part of a staff at Heidelberg that completely turned the program around.

UP NEXT: Otterbein will not play at home again for over a month, taking on three-straight road games with a bye week sandwiched between. The Cards will begin the stretch next Saturday afternoon with a pivotal game at Ohio Northern.
