CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: Otterbein begins a fourweek stretch that will consist of three road games and a bye week. The Cards head to Ohio Northern looking to stay perfect on the year and avenge a 16-10 loss from last season that was decided in the final few minutes. ONU has won four-straight games in this series.



A LOOK AT ONU: The Polar Bears, under the direction of 14th-year head coach Dean Paul, are looking to bounce back after a 40-21 home loss to Heidelberg last Saturday. Ohio Northern slipped past Adrian for a 35-31 victory in its opener before surrendering 655 yards of total offense last week. ONU has had just one losing season since 2004 and made NCAA playoff appearances in 2010 and 2016.

GAME NOTES (CONT. ON NEXT PAGE)

LAST MEETING: Both teams battled through a low-scoring, but hard-hitting affair last fall in Westerville. Otterbein appeared to have tied the game on a 28-yd TD pass from Logan Stepp to Hunter Joseph with 3:22 remaining, but offensive pass interference was called and the Cards eventually came up just short in a 16-10 loss.

POLAR BEARS ON HOME ICE: Otterbein has not won at Ohio Northern since 2008, when the Cardinals went 9-1 in the regular season and made their only postseason appearance. The last matchup at Dial-Roberson Stadium ended with a 42-10 ONU win.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "This is a big challenge for us," Doup said. "Going up to Ada is not easy and they will surely want to prove something after getting beat by Heidelberg. They are athletic with dangerous players, and will try to run it down your throat if they can. Williams is a great tailback and runs with great vision. Their offensive balance keeps you on your toes so we can't get caught out of position."

GAME NOTES CONT...

STEPP RIGHT UP: Senior quarterback Logan Stepp currently ranks second nationally in points responsible for (84), fourth in passing efficiency (213.6), ninth in total offense per game (381.3) and 15th in passing yards (936).

ON THE DEFENSIVE: With two more interceptions last week against Wilmington, the Cardinal defense now has more picks this season (7) than it did all of last year (6). Freshman Brandon Paschal leads the way with three, tallying one in each game thus far.

PRINCE CHARMING: Junior DB Prince Franklin II had a 26-yard interception return for a touchdown last week for his first pick in an Otterbein uniform. That play marked the first defensive TD for the Cards since early in the 2015 season, when former all-region linebacker Drew Ervin sealed a road win at Marietta with 43-yard pick six.

UP AND RUNNING: Otterbein posted rushing touchdowns from four different players against Wilmington. In addition to Stepp's score in the first half, running backs Isaiah Richmond, Christian Johnson and Dakota "Boobie" Smith all scored in the second half. Smith's came from 49 yards out on his first attempt of the game.

ALL EYES ON 5: Both teams have key players donning a #5 jersey. Logan Stepp and Kyle Blust wear the numeral for Otterbein as part of the tradition to honor former Cardinal Josh Worthington, who passed away in a car accident back in 2004. On the opposite side, Ohio Northern standout running back Christiaan Williams wears #5 for his squad. His streak of 11-straight 100-yard rushing games was snapped last week by Heidelberg, although he did surpass 100 all-purpose yards.

THIRD DEGREE: Otterbein enters this week ranked fourth in the nation for third-down offense, having converted 21 of 36 opportunities for a 58.3% output so far. The Polar Bears have moved the chains successfully on 15 of 31 (.484) third downs.

FROM FRIEND TO FOE: Recent graduate assistant coach David Carroll, who oversaw wide receivers at Otterbein from 2015-17, is now in his first season as a member of the ONU staff. He is familiar with the Cardinal offense and will present an interesting dynamic of cat and mouse this week.

UP NEXT: Otterbein will return to Westerville and begin preparing for its cross-town trip to rival Capital. The always intense and emotional battle will take place as part of Capital's Homecoming weekend.
