CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: Otterbein looks to shake off last week's disappointing 48-45 OT loss at Heidelberg, who is now back in the national poll. The Cards host Baldwin Wallace during Hall of Fame weekend on campus with their annual night game under the lights.



A LOOK AT BW: The Yellow Jackets, under first-year head coach Jim Hilvert, travel to Westerville holding an identical record to the Cardinals. BW is fresh off a 23-20 win at Muskingum in which kicker Brandon Vollmer made three field goals, including the game-winner with 2:14 to play, en route to OAC 'Special Teams Player of the Week' honors. Hilvert went 67-19 at Thomas More from 2007-15 before recently leading Cincinnati La Salle HS to OHSAA state titles in 2015 and 2016.

LAST MEETING: Otterbein emerged with a hard-fought 33-30 victory in Berea last year as running back Isaiah Richmond punched in the game-winning touchdown with 32 seconds left. QB Logan Stepp threw for 229 yards and ran for another 117.

NIGHT NIGHT: The Cardinals had won seven-straight night games prior to last week's narrow defeat at Heidelberg. Otterbein has averaged 32.6 points per game under the lights of Memorial Stadium over the past five seasons.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "My guys are ready to play," head coach Tim Doup said. "They were ready to compete again right away after Heidelberg. That loss obviously hurt, and it's supposed to hurt. But I saw what they were made of as human beings last week and we are anxious to get back on the field against another team with the same record as us. There is something new to play for every Saturday. It will be a big game for us when you assess the 10-week schedule, so we pick ourselves up and move forward."

GAME NOTES CONT...

LET ME CLEAR MY THROAT: Senior defensive end Kyle Blust had quite an impressive performance last year at Baldwin Wallace, tying for a game-high 10 tackles (four for a loss) and a sack despite playing with strep throat. He fought through sickness to lead Otterbein's second-half defensive charge and ultimately earn OAC Player of the Week.

LOWE AND BEHOLD: Senior wide receiver Julian Lowe left it all on the field last week at Heidelberg, catching 11 passes for a career-high 178 yards and two touchdowns for the offense. He also delivered a 95-yard kickoff return for a TD, marking the first for Otterbein since All-American Dominic Jones housed three of them in 2010.

PICKS BY PASCHAL: Freshman defensive back Brandon Paschal has been a pleasant addition this year, most recently earning OAC 'Defensive Player of the Week' honors after making 11 tackles and two interceptions at Heidelberg. He leads the OAC and ranks fourth in the country with five picks so far this year.

OH, HOYLE RULES: Freshman kicker David Hoyle had a memorable moment in the game at Heidelberg, drilling a 49-yard field goal with :08 remaining that forced overtime. His father, Jim, was a first team All-America placekicker for the Cards and still holds a pair of school records; most field goals in a career (27) and tied for most field goals in a single game (4). David began this year as the third-string kicker before working his way up.

WHAT GIVES?: Otterbein's high-powered offense behind signal caller Logan Stepp will challenge the solid BW defense. The Yellow Jackets are allowing 24.3 ppg. this season, second-best in the league and also inflated by Mount Union's 55 points a month ago, while the Cardinals are posting nearly 40 points per outing.

STANDING IN THE HALL OF FAME: Otterbein will induct six individuals into its Athletics Hall of Fame this weekend; Mark Burns (XC/Track - 1983), Ralph Picklesimer (Football - 1950), Tim Pond (Men's Basketball - 1967), Dan Remenowsky (Baseball - 2008), Carol Smith (Women's Basketball - 1969) and Ray Watts (Multiple Sports/Administrator - 1918) Picklesimer was an All-OAC center on the heralded 1946 football team while Watts was the AD and coach for all sports before going on to a remarkable career at BW. He is now in the Hall of Fame for both schools.

UP NEXT: The Cardinals will hit the road for a test at No.2-ranked Mount Union, which has won 24 of the past 25 OAC titles and made the NCAA semifinals last fall before coming up short to eventual champion Mary Hardin-Baylor.
