CARDINAL FOOTBALL

THIS WEEK: Otterbein faces its toughest challenge of the season, heading to No. 2-ranked and league-leading Mount Union. The Cardinals need one more win over their final three games to secure a winning season after last week's triumph over Baldwin Wallace.

vs. RAIDERS

A LOOK AT MOUNT UNION: The Purple Raiders, under the direction of fifth-year head coach Vince Kehres, had won 24-straight OAC titles before the streak was snapped last year by John Carroll. Despite that, they have advanced to the NCAA semifinals every year since 1995, losing to eventual champion Mary Hardin-Baylor last fall. Mount currently leads the nation in scoring at almost 61 points per game, and ranks second in scoring defense at 7.4 ppg.

GAME NOTES (CONT. ON NEXT PAGE)

A GOOD CHRISTIAN: Junior running back Christian Johnson had a career night last week against Baldwin Wallace, scampering 23 times for 207 yards and a touchdown. He is averaging 7.1 yards per carry over his last three outings.

LOWE KEY: Senior wide receiver Julian Lowe caught two more TD passes last week and now needs just one more to tie the Otterbein all-time record of 29, set by former All-American tight end Jeff Gibbs from 1998-2001. Lowe, the OAC Indoor record holder in the 200-meter dash (22.19), has been at Otterbein for three years since transferring from Akron.

WHAT TO EXPECT: "You don't get crazy, try to do what you do best and limit big plays from occurring," Doup said when asked about Mount Union. "Special teams are crucial and we will try to make their offense earn everything. Picking up first downs will be key in attempt to control the ball and put points on the board. You can't miss on red-zone opportunities."

GAME NOTES CONT...

MR. SMITH: Otterbein running backs coach Dave Smith will be in familiar territory, returning to his alma mater where he graduated in 1977. He was a two-year letterman at the same position, with his best rushing day coming on 15 carries for 113 yards and a score against Saint Joseph's in 1975.

OUT IN FRONT: The offensive line had perhaps its best game of 2017 last week, paving the way for a season-best 368 yards on the ground. The unit features seniors Case Troyer (LT) and Jacob Schafer (C), juniors Peter LaChapelle (RG) and Jared Conover (RT), and sophomore Winston Spiker (LG).

INTERCEPTING DUO: Safety Fred Hardgrove and defensive back Brandon Paschal, both first-year players on defense, both have five interceptions this season to rank tied for eighth in the country. Paschal had two at Heidelberg before Hardgrove made a leaping grab last week against BW.

CRAZY CONFERENCE: The always-competitive Ohio Athletic Conference has seen some wild games so far this season. Just last week, Marietta pulled a 44-21 upset win over nationally-ranked Heidelberg and Muskingum missed a short field goal that resulted in a 7-6 loss to Ohio Northern. Otterbein went down to the wire with Capital (49-42), Wilmington snapped a 39-game losing streak in OAC play, and many other competitive matchups have taken place.

THIRD DEGREE: Third down will be a key factor for the Cardinals to maintain possession. Otterbein has converted 49% of chances this season, but the Mount Union defense is allowing just a 23-percent success rate. The Cards were just 2 of 12 last year while the Raiders went 12 of 13.

GLASS HALF FULL: Mount Union quarterback D'Angelo Fulford has a clean passing line of 29 touchdowns and no interceptions on the season, while also adding four additional scores on the ground. He leads the nation in passing efficiency and is tied atop all of Division III in points responsible for (198).

UP NEXT: The Cardinals will return home for the final game inside Memorial Stadium this season, playing host to John Carroll at 1:30 p.m. It will be Senior Day as more than 20 players are scheduled to be recognized.
