# SEASON PREVIEW



WESTERVILLE, Ohio - Otterbein returns to the field in 2017 with deep feelings of motivation and renewal after settling for a 5-5 season last fall. The Cardinals dropped three games by a combined 10 points and feel they could have very easily posted an 8-2 record.

The program, under now sixth-year head coach Tim Doup, has progressed through spring ball and the summer months with a slew of confidence as 15 of 22 starters are set to return. Nine of those starters are back for the offense, which averaged 30 points per game last year and features a ton of dangerous weapons.

"There is obvious excitement when you have this many pieces back, but we are looking to maintain an even keel," Doup said. "It's a matter of reeling everyone in and moving game by game. Having 20-plus seniors that hold experience in the trenches makes all the difference. Now it's time to see who did what they were supposed to in the offseason."

Back to handle the offensive reins will be first team All-OAC quarterback Logan Stepp, coming off a breakout junior season in which he switched from wide receiver to ultimately led the league in total offense per game (268.7) and finish second with 25 touchdowns. The dual-threat signal caller completed 60 percent of his passes for 1,917 yards, 17 TD's and just three interceptions while also rushing for 770 yards and another eight scores.

"He is a natural leader," Doup said. "He holds people accountable and wants to make our team, and this campus, the best it can be. My expectations for him are now very high. There is obvious pressure because teams will game plan with all eyes on Logan, but I expect him to handle it well."

Stepp will have no shortage of options at his disposal, beginning with a pair of All-OAC wideouts in seniors Hunter Joseph and Julian Lowe. Joseph ranked second in the conference last year with 777 receiving yards, despite missing a game, while Lowe was top-three in both catches (56) and touchdowns (8). Also returning for the aerial gang is speedy junior Payton Vanderkooi out of the slot, senior Tyler Sorg out wide and senior right end Josh Plieninger, who also plays a key role in the blocking game.

The two-headed monster of Christian Johnson (5-6, 180) and Isaiah Richmond (6-0, 230) returns to the backfield, combining for 702 yards and 11 touchdowns last season while sharing the rushing load with Stepp.

"Everyone naturally wants to touch the ball, but I'm not sure anyone will touch it as much as they want," Doup said. "We are a team. The more you can spread things around, the more problems you can give an opponent. We continue having conversations with our skill guys on this aspect and they all understand. I'm excited to see each of them make their touches count."

The group will operate behind an offensive line that brings back four regulars, led by three-year tackle Case Troyer (29 starts) and two-year center Jacob Schafer. Winston Spiker started all 10 games last year as a true freshman while Peter LaChapelle filled in five games to accommodate injuries.

The defense returns six starters to the mix, headlined by two-time All-OAC defensive end Kyle Blust. He finished third in the league last year with 16.5 tackles for loss, including nine sacks, as part of 48 total tackles.

"Kyle is a tremendous athlete and just so strong," Doup said. "The things he can do on a football field can really propel a defense. He really broke out last year and now I'm ready to see what he does in his final go-around. We will certainly have to lean on him at times."

Other starters back to help include defensive lineman Andre Douglas, linebackers Austin Jones and Jake Harper, along with secondary members Steven Carpenter (safety) and Prince Franklin II (corner). A vast array of returning talent will join them on that side of the ball, including five individuals who started at least one game and/or rotated in frequently last year.

"We have a lot of guys that have been in the fire already on defense," Doup explained. "The front seven is balanced but we always focus on finding depth. Then we will probably move some things around in the secondary, which might be a small learning process, but I really like our options from an athleticism standpoint."

All-OAC placekicker Joe Sanfillipo, who handles the punting duties as well, returns for his junior campaign after leading the team and finishing 12th in the OAC in scoring (60 points). Also an all-conference performer in lacrosse, "Flip" averaged nearly 40 yards per punt, placed seven inside the 20, and nailed two of his nine made field goals from 44 and 47 yards.

"He can do it all," Doup said. "The kicking game is always crucial and we have a guy that we trust to get us points. Having a returning all-conference leg of Flip's caliber is just huge."

Alongside Sanfillipo, the Cards will bring back holder Lukas Ousley, Sorg at long snapper and all options in the return game.

Otterbein opens the season with a non-conference game at nearby Ohio Wesleyan on September 2 before launching the OAC schedule come Saturday, Sept. 9 against Muskingum inside Memorial Stadium.

"I want to hit the ground running," Doup said emphatically. "We have a bunch of high motors and should be able to pick things up quickly, with few mistakes. I'm ready for an up-tempo camp with high expectations and an attitude of working for one another."

He snagged six TD's and posted a 2016 OAC single-game best 221 receiving yards against Heidelberg..

The Cardinals turned in a memorable night game as part of Hall of Fame weekend on October 15, flying past Heidelberg by a score of 45-38 in the annual Rhine River Cup showdown. Otterbein snapped a five-game losing skid in the series, racking up a whopping 579 yards of total offense and possessing the ball for almost 36 minutes. The 579 yards was the most in a game since the turn of the century.

# HEAD COACH TIM DOUP



Tim Doup begins his sixth season as head football coach at Otterbein University.

A 1992 graduate of Otterbein, Coach Doup, 49, took over the head coaching duties in 2012 after serving as the team's offensive coordinator for nine seasons. He led the Cards to an 8-2 record his first season and was selected Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) football Coach of the Year as a result. His career mark currently stands at 27-23.

Doup, a native of Delaware, Ohio, has been a key ingredient in the uptick of Otterbein football. The Cardinals compiled a 49-42 record over his nine seasons as offensive coordinator, including a 9-2 record in 2008 and 8-2 in 2009. The 2008 squad made the NCAA Division III playoffs for the first time in school history. Doup was named OAC Assistant Coach of the Year in 2008, leading an offense that generated 380 yards and 39 points a game.

Doup, who began coaching linebackers in 2015 after many years overseeing the offensive line, possesses more than 20 years of football coaching experience. Before returning to his alma mater in 2003, he served eight seasons as an assistant football coach at Upper Arlington High School in Ohio from 1995 to 2002. Over the course of his career there, Upper Arlington won five conference championships (1997-2000 and 2002), advanced to the Division I State Final Four in 1997 and 1998, and won the state title in 2000. He was selected Central Ohio Division I assistant coach of the year in 1997. Doup also taught physical education at Upper Arlington from 1998 to 2002.

Other coaching assignments include assistant wrestling coach at Upper Arlington (1991-2002) as well as assistant track coach (1991-95) and assistant football coach (1991-94) at Olentangy High School in Ohio.

A 1992 graduate of Otterbein, with a degree in physical education, Doup was a four-year letterman at center and served as football captain his senior year. He received his master's degree in the art of teaching from Marygrove College in 2002.

Coach Doup, and his wife, Helyn, have three children: a son, Colton, 17, and 14-year-old twins, son, Kaden, and daughter, Kennedie. They live in Lewis Center, Ohio.

## ASSISTANT COACHES



### ALLAN MOORE (Otterbein '98)

Allan Moore begins his 15th season at his alma mater, serving as defensive coordinator and, for the second year, also coaching defensive backs. Coach Moore was instrumental in putting together a defense that led the Ohio Athletic Conference in turnover margin and finished second in total defense and scoring defense in 2012. He taught health and physical education classes at Northmor (OH) High School where he served as head football coach (2000-03) and assistant football coach/defensive coordinator (1998-2000). While at Northmor, he also assisted in wrestling and track and field. Moore received his bachelor's degree in physical education from Otterbein University in 1998. He was a four-year letterman who captained the football team his senior season and received the Heart & Hustle Award in 1996. ## **JAMES HUDDLESTON (Ohio Wesleyan '13)**

## **JOEL LOHOUA (Denison '17)**

Joel Lohoua enters his first year as a defensive graduate assistant coach for Otterbein, primarily assisting with the defensive backs. A recent 2017 graduate of Denison University, Lohoua suffered a season-ending injury for the Big Red as a freshman but returned to start all 30 games over his final three seasons. 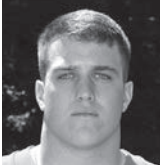

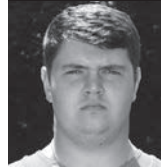

# DR. KATHY KRENDL



President Kathy A. Krendl, the 20th president and the first woman to lead Otterbein University, took office July 1, 2009. President Krendl received her bachelor's degree in English from Lawrence University, her master's degree in journalism from The Ohio State University and her doctorate in communication from the University of Michigan. After holding teaching and administrative positions at Indiana University from 1983 through 1996, President Krendl joined Ohio University as dean of the Scripps College of Communication. In 2004, she was appointed Executive Vice President and Provost at Ohio University.



During President Krendl's tenure, Otterbein has changed its name from College to University. It has also developed and launched its new undergraduate curriculum with its transition to semesters. The curriculum focuses on the distinctive character of Otterbein's unique combination of curricular and experiential learning. In addition, since 2009, the institution has developed several new graduate programs in nursing, education, and business, including its first doctoral program, the Doctorate in Nursing Practice. Otterbein has also reached out to the region with the introduction of summer camps for audiences of all ages, a growing number of online courses, and the Otterbein Collegiate Institute, offering college courses for high school students. The institution has signed six new associate to baccalaureate degree agreements with six two-year institutions in the region, along with its long-standing partnership and an innovative new dual admission program with Columbus State Community College.

Most recently, President Krendl oversaw the development of The Point — Otterbein's new STEAM innovation center. The center connects learners and educators with partners from the private and public sectors in central Ohio in one location to create a unique resource for students, entrepreneurs and the community. Since President Krendl's appointment, Otterbein was named a top 10 "Up and Comer" by its peers in the "Guide to America's Best Colleges" by *U.S. News & World Report* and is ranked 11th among 149 schools in its category. The American Association of Colleges and Universities selected Otterbein as one of six national demonstration sites for experiential learning, along with Georgetown and Tufts. The University's emphasis on student engagement in community service led *Washington Monthly* to recognize Otterbein as a top school for contributions to the public good. Otterbein also has been consistently recognized with distinction on the President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll through the Corporation for National and Community Service.

President Krendl resides in Westerville with her husband, Richard S. Gilbert, who teaches journalism and communication at Otterbein. Their children, Claire and Tom, have pursued academic careers.

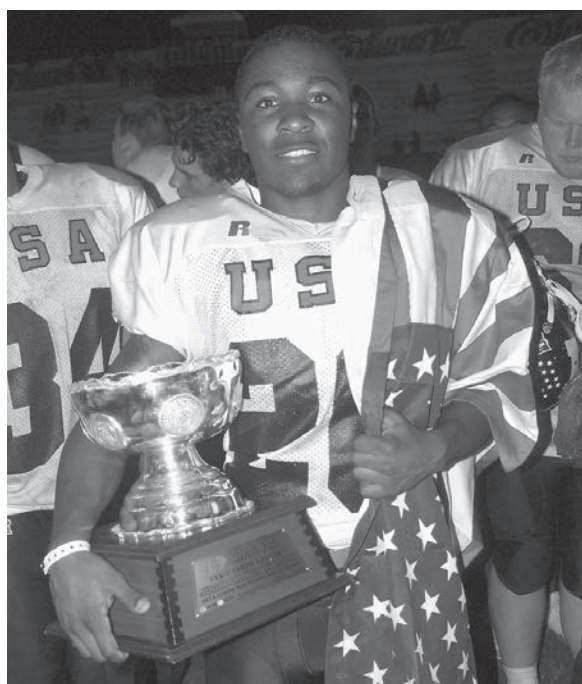

# FACILITIES



A new era in Otterbein football began in the fall of 2005 as the Cardinals moved into a new home in Memorial Stadium.

The \$3.2 million grandstand, built on the same site of old Memorial Stadium, was dedicated on Sept. 17, 2006 shortly before Otterbein defeated cross-town rival Capital, 17-14, by scoring on its last two possessions of the game.

The grandstand was financed through private funds, raised through the Clements Foundation and the Otterbein "O" Club, both long-time contributors to athletics and other academic programs at Otterbein.

The grandstand, with handicap access, seats 2,400, including a section in the middle with 500 stadium chairs, and a press box with elevator. The stadium also features state-of-the-art locker rooms, a training room, equipment room, and "O" Club room.

Memorial Stadium received a \$2.1 million upgrade over the summer of 2014. The natural grass surface was replaced with Crossflex HP turf and a new 13-millimeter sandwich track was installed.

Lights, courtesy of Cellular One, were added to Memorial Stadium in 1996.



The Frank and Vida Clements Recreation and Fitness Center opened in the fall of 2002.

The \$9.5 million center enhances the curriculum and clinical experiences for students preparing for careers in health, fitness and athletic training. In addition, the center significantly increases the facilities for the athletic training, sport management, and health and fitness programs; increases the health, wellness and recreation programs for students, faculty and staff; enhances Otterbein's capacity to attract future students; and expands the opportunities for partnership with the wider Columbus community.

The center has two components: a 75,000 square-foot field house, complete with a sanctioned six-lane, 200-meter indoor track; and a two-story connector to the existing Rike Center, which features a high-tech cardiovascular fitness area, fully-equipped training and rehabilitation center, coaching offices, classrooms and a student lounge area.

Built in 1974, the Rike Center houses physical education facilities and offices. The domed roof encloses an intercollegiate hardwood basketball floor with seating for 3,100; equipped weight training room; two handball courts; and locker rooms for varsity teams and physical education classes. Conventional classrooms and offices are located on the perimeter.

A \$300,000 gift from the Rike family of Dayton inaugurated the capital campaign to finance construction of the Rike Center, which was built for about \$1.5 million.

In the spring of 2008, an \$84,000 weight room was installed in the Rike Center, providing new flooring, free weights and equipment for use by student-athletes, students and staff. The project was spearheaded by the "O" Club with support from Robert Corbin '49, Tom Weisenstein and the Fishbaugh Memorial Fund.

Additional sports facilities at Otterbein include tennis courts, and separate fields for softball, baseball and soccer. A 2.5-mile cross country course, which meanders Alum Creek and traverses woods and farmland, opened in the fall of 1995. Gifts from the Otterbein alumni and friends have helped provide educational

opportunities through athletics for sports-minded students. Former student-athletes have continued their success in coaching, teaching, recreational and professional fields-evidence of quality educational experiences offered at Otterbein University.







# ADMINISTRATION

Dawn Stewart enters her sixth year as director of athletics for her alma mater. A 1998 graduate, she was hired on April 9, 2012 after Otterbein conducted a national search that netted over 100 applicants vying for the position. Stewart came to Otterbein from Capital University where she has served four years as athletic director. She holds 21 years of experience within intercollegiate athletics at the NCAA Division I and III levels as an athletics administrator and former student-athlete. Since her arrival, Stewart has launched the Roush Hall of Champions interactive display, highlighting standout individuals and teams throughout the history of Cardinal athletics. She has also spearheaded the Turf and Track project in Memorial Stadium, completed in 2014, and was most recently named one of four Under Armour AD of the Year Award winners within Division III by NACDA. Stewart, who was elected president of the Collegiate Event and Facility Management Association in 2013, began her professional career at Otterbein in 1998 by serving as recruiting coordinator and assistant women's tennis coach. She then transitioned to the University of Dayton in 2000. At Dayton, Stewart worked from the ground up, first serving as director of ticketing services before being promoted to assistant director of athletics for business and communications in 2002. In 2007, she was named senior woman administrator, and in addition to continuing to manage a \$17 million budget and athletics communication, was placed in charge of the office of athletics academic affairs. Stewart was hired into her athletic director role at Capital in 2008 where she managed 18 varsity sports, along with 50 full- and part-time coaches and administrative personnel. Stewart received her bachelor's degree in business administration from Otterbein in 1998. She holds a master's degree in sport management from The Ohio State University and is working on her doctorate in sport management at Ohio State. A native of New Philadelphia, Ohio, Stewart and her husband, Steve, a 1998 graduate of Otterbein, now live in Westerville with their 1-year old son, Jack..

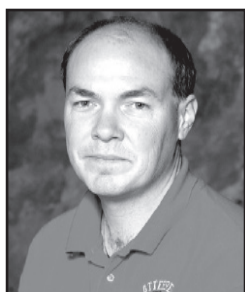

## The University

Otterbein University is a small private university nationally-recognized for its intentional blending of liberal arts and professional studies through its renowned Integrative Studies curriculum and its commitments to experiential learning and community engagement. Otterbein consistently stands in its category's top 20 in *U.S. News & World Report's* guide to "America's Best Colleges." It has been accredited since 1913 by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

## Location

Its picturesque campus is perfectly situated in Westerville, Ohio, America's fifth friendliest town (*Forbes*), just minutes from Columbus, the 14th largest city in the country.

## Enrollment

Otterbein offers more than 70 undergraduate majors; seven master's programs; and a doctorate in nursing practice (DNP). Otterbein's commitment to opportunity started with its founding in 1847 as one of the nation's first universities to welcome women and persons of color to its community of teachers and learners, which now numbers 2,400 undergraduate and 500 graduate students. Otterbein remains committed to its relationship with the United Methodist Church and its spirit of inclusion, and welcomes people of all backgrounds to Otterbein's Model Community.

## The Campus

Otterbein's 140-acre campus in the heart of Westerville includes the historic Towers Hall, constructed in 1872. Renowned for its Department of Theatre and Dance, Otterbein students perform plays for the community in The Fritsche Theatre at Cowan Hall, which was renovated in 2005. The Department of Art displays art from students, faculty, the University collection and visiting exhibits in the Miller Gallery in the Art and Communication Building, Fisher Gallery in Roush Hall, and the Frank Museum of Art. The Department of Music also offers public performances of opera, symphony, marching band and student choral groups. Classes began in fall 2016 at The Point, Otterbein's new STEAM Innovation Center, brings students in science, technology, engineering, mathematics and arts programs together with professionals from leading private and public sector organizations for unique experiential learning opportunities, leading to internships and job placements.

## Faculty

Otterbein's student-to-faculty ratio of 11:1 offers students the opportunity to receive personalized attention from their instructors. Professors are active in campus affairs, serve as advisers to students, and participate in a unique sabbatical program to research and study recent developments in their fields.

## Athletics

Men and women compete in the Ohio Athletic Conference, NCAA Division III. There are 11 varsity sports for men and 10 for women. A complete intramural program is available to all students.

## Community Service

The White House has recognized Otterbein "With Distinction" on the President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll every year since it was created. In 2008, Otterbein won the President's Award for General Community Service. Approximately 80 percent of the student body participated in community service giving 70,000 hours of service to the community. In addition, 60 service-learning courses enrolled over 1,000 students that same year. Otterbein has been recognized by *Washington Monthly* as a Top 50 school for contributions to the public good.

## The Arts

Professional training programs are available in theatre, dance, music and visual arts. There are numerous cultural events free to students throughout the year.

## Global and Intercultural Engagement

Students have the opportunity at Otterbein to study abroad and to participate in local and regional cultural immersion programs. Through intercultural experiences, students gain a deeper

knowledge of and respect for another culture's worldview, its values, customs, and traditions. They may develop greater linguistic proficiency in another language and the ability to engage in meaningful communication with people in another culture. Students also develop global and cross-cultural competencies as they gain a deeper appreciation for diversity.

## Costs
