GAME NOTES:

ROUND TWO: Otterbein and Ohio Wesleyan are playing in the second affair of a home-and-home series that began last season, when the Cards made the short trip up to Delaware and pulled away for a 36-15 victory. It was the first meeting between the schools since 1989.

LAST SHOWDOWN: Ohio Wesleyan led 8-7 midway through the second quarter last fall before Otterbein seized control for good. The Cards scored in the final minute of the second quarter, took a 14-8 lead into halftime, and then rattled off four-straight scoring drives throughout the second half. Former QB Logan Stepp threw for a career-high 402 yards in the victory while Julian Lowe had nine grabs for 147 yards.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Otterbein lost eight All-OAC selections from last year, along with a handful of other key contributors on both sides of the ball. As a result, the squad returns just seven positional starters and will feature some new faces at key positions.

EVEN STEVEN: Senior quarterback Steven Irwin patiently waited his turn behind Stepp the past couple of years, and appears to be in line for his first-collegiate start behind center against OWU. He has attempted just 14 career passes but is also a dual-threat with his legs, rushing for 237 yards on the ground during his back-up duty.

9 TO 5: Fifth-year receiver Payton Vanderkooi was recently selected by the coaching staff to wear #5 this season and carry on the tradition of remembering former Cardinal Josh Worthington, who was killed in a car accident back in 2004. The honor, typically presented to a senior, goes not only to a respected player but also someone of great character and work ethic. Vanderkooi will be transitioning from the #9 he wore last year.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE: Senior defensive end Andre Douglas returns in the best shape of his life, recently dropping 25 lbs over the summer and impressing throughout preseason camp with a newfound speed. He started eight games last year and has played in 27 overall since arriving to campus.

SMACK DAB IN THE MIDDLE: The Cardinal defense will surely be relying on the duo of inside linebackers Jake Harper and Ryan Tuchow, who combined for over 100 tackles last year and trained together in the offseason. Harper, a team captain who attended OAC Media Day in July, actually led Otterbein in tackling as a sophomore and has started 20-straight contests.

ALONG THE LINE: The offensive line will look to anchor the unit early on as skill positions sort themselves out. Starters Jared Conover (tackle) and Winston Spiker (guard) are back once again while the group should also receive a boost from Anthony Andrews, who started last year's opener at OWU before suffering a season-ending injury. Evan Kennaley and Josh Davis appear ready to slide in after gaining experience as backups last campaign.

COACH COMMENTS: "We are excited to finally get things going again and see how well we prepared throughout the offseason," Doup says. "So much has been talked about, game planned, dissected and transitioned since the final game of last year. There's not much more to do now except strap it up, put the shoulder pads on and take the field come Saturday."
