GAME NOTES:

RECENT HISTORY: Otterbein is 5-1 against Baldwin Wallace under Doup, including victories the last two years by scores of 33-30 and 37-29, respectively. BW threw for 325 yards in the game last fall but the Cards countered with a season-best 368 on the ground. That contest featured 976 yards of total offense combined between the schools.

RY GUY: Linebacker Ryan Tuchow was everywhere against Ohio Wesleyan, tallying a teamhigh 10 tackles (3.5 for loss) to go along with two sacks and a forced fumble. He was making the first start of his career after playing 19 games as a key backup over the past two seasons.

THE NIALL RIVER: Memorial Stadium was soaked with water by the time last Saturday's game ended, but the Cards weathered the storm and escaped as safety Niall Lewison blocked a potential game-tying field-goal attempt from OWU in the closing seconds. The redshirt sophomore also had eight tackles (six solo) in his first game since 2016.

SORRY ABOUT THAT: Otterbein will be looking to clean up the penalties after a flagg-filled first outing, which saw the Cards get whistled 12 times for 119 yards. BW committed eight for 78 yards against Alma as both teams will surely look to play a cleaner game this time.

CURIOUS GEORGE: Sophomore George Redding made his first-career start in the slot against OWU in place of Payton Vanderkooi, and the speedster had some intriguing moments with five catches for 39 yards. He also nearly hauled in a long grab up the seam before a flying safety came in to deliver a hard hit and dislodge the ball. Redding is the younger cousin of former Mount Union standout and NFL wide receiver Cecil Shorts III.

COACH DOUP COMMENTS:

On battling the elements against Ohio Wesleyan:

"As young as we are and with as many things that went wrong, I was proud of our effort and resolve. We had turnovers, we had weather, we had penalties and we had breakdowns, but the guys stayed focused and ultimately made the crucial plays at crucial times."

On the defense allowing OWU just seven points:

"I thought we were pretty good defensively with forcing turnovers, creating sacks and only allowing the one big play. They got put in some bad situations but kept running out there and never gave up. You can't coach effort, and you saw that come to fruition at the end with us blocking a kick with the game on the line."

On safety Niall Lewison's return after missing the entire 2017 season with an injury:

"Niall had to sit back and be our camera guy last year. He filmed every practice and remained with us at all times despite not being able to put a uniform on. I think it shows what kind of kid he is. Then he comes back this year, wins a starting job in camp and has a debut like that. Blocking the kick and helping us win that game couldn't have happened to a better person."

On playing Baldwin Wallace:

"We have to schematically counteract their strong suits and knock off mistakes, because BW is really good. They are bigger than they have been up front, have a three-year starting QB and a bunch of weapons at his disposal. That defense flew around last week and we'll need to find a way to match the physicality. You can already see their confidence on film and the challenges they will present teams this season."
