GAME NOTES:

RECENT HISTORY: John Carroll has taken the last six meetings, including a 45-0 victory last season up in University Heights on its way to a 9-1 regular-season record and NCAA playoff appearance. Otterbein's last win over JCU came during the 2012 schedule, a 21-7 triumph, as Doup went on to earn OAC Coach of the Year honors in his inaugural campaign.

SCHMEL THE ROSES: Sophomore Luke Schmeling, a converted quarterback, did a little bit of everything last week against Baldwin Wallace. He rushed for almost 100 yards out of the wildcat, including a 56-yard TD, while catching a pass and also completing another.

BOST WITH THE MOST: Freshman running back Jordan Bost-Floyd has shown nice flashes so far in his young career. The 5-6 speedster had 52 yards and a touchdown in the home opener, including an 11-yard touchdown scamper through the middle.

TAKE IT TO THE HOUSE: Sophomore Brandon Paschal had a 61-yard interception return for a touchdown in the second quarter last week, making the score 14-7 at the time. It was the second pick-six in the last three games for Paschal, who missed all of last season but returned an INT for a score in the 2017 season finale at Marietta.

WHO BROUGHT THE GOYA BEANS?: Fans will receive free admission on Saturday with the donation of a canned food item, which can be placed into bins set up near entry gates.

HONOR OF 5 CELEBRATION: One of the more heartfelt traditions in small-college football, the coaching staff has selected one upperclassmen each year to wear No. 5 and help carry on the honor of Josh Worthington, who was killed in a car accident on Christmas Eve, 2004, but has not been forgotten. The Worthington family is returning publicly for the first time in 15 years on Saturday to meet all of the men who have worn the number in the time span.

COACH DOUP COMMENTS:

On the different capabilities of Luke Schmeling's impact:

"He is a playmaker. When he decided to switch from quarterback, we had to find ways to get him on the field. You saw his versatility against BW and that's exactly what we are looking for. I was happy to see him feeling good last week and providing a spark."

On the team being minus eight in turnover margin:

"You can't win football games turning the ball over, and we have done that two weeks in a row. We can outgain opponents by 200 yards and it won't matter if you're giving them 21 defensive points. The self-inflicted stuff has to be eliminated."

On the Worthington family returning to campus for No. 5 recognition ceremony:

"I think it will be a special moment for the Worthington family and also for these former players, who have never all been in the same room together. Everyone knows what the #5 represents, so we hope it will be a positive experience while paying tribute to Josh. These guys were not only impact players, but high character young men who have continued doing things the right way."

On challenges of playing John Carroll:

"They are physical, play great defense and have had two weeks to prepare. I'm guessing their bodies are a lot more healed than ours and probably feeling pretty good. Their program has been consistently good in recent years but we need to focus on our side of things and correct our mistakes first."
