## GAME NOTES:

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Otterbein gets back on the bus to continue a lengthy stretch of away games, which features three road contests sandwiched around a bye week. All in all, the Cardinals will have 35 days between home events until Muskingum comes to town in late October.

**STOP IT:** Safety Niall Lewison currently ranks second in the conference at 11.3 tackles per game, making 25 solo and another 25 assisted so far this season. A returning All-OAC performer, he has led the Cardinal defense in stops all four games.

**MAY THE FOURTH BE WITH YOU:** Otterbein was 6 of 7 on fourth down last week at Ohio Northern, with two of those conversions being touchdown plays. The Cards were 7 of 17 on fourth down all of last season.

**RED ALERT:** Speedster George Redding currently leads the team in receptions after making six grabs for 47 yards last week at ONU. The junior can be used in a variety of ways, whether it be from the slot, from the backfield or on punt/kick returns. He is the younger cousin of former Mount Union All-American and NFL wideout Cecil Shorts III.

**TURN FOR THE BETTER:** Otterbein has not committed a turnover the last two weeks after oddly committing nine over the first two games. The Cards were even in that category with nationally-ranked John Carroll and then also at Ohio Northern.

**GLANCE AT MOUNT UNION:** The Purple Raiders have made at least the NCAA semifinals for 24 years in a row. Mount fell 24-16 in last year's national title game to Mary Hardin-Baylor, beat UMHB to claim the 2017 championship, and lost to the Crusaders in the 2016 semifinal round. Justin Hill has 46 career touchdown catches, one shy of matching former standout Pierre Garcon, while fellow receiver Darian Littlejohn leads the OAC and currently ranks top-15 nationally in kickoff return average at 31.2 yards per runback.

### COACH DOUP COMMENTS:

#### *On playing Mount Union:*

"If you want to become a successful program, you have to learn and play the best. That holds true in probably any sport. We get that opportunity every year to see them across the field and across the line of scrimmage. It gives you a first-hand idea of what that greatness looks like and certainly presents a challenge to improve."

#### *On Niall Lewison's production for the defense:*

"Niall is very competitive, knows where he is supposed to be and always does what he is taught. He is just a good football player, and everything you want in a safety back there."

#### *On Bryce Hall, Logan Pharmer and Luke Schmeling all taking snaps behind center:*

"They all bring something different. Bryce is knowledgeable and understands the offense. Logan has mobility and a carefree approach. Luke brings a little bit of everything and is dynamic. I think you have to prepare a little bit differently for each of them."
