RECENT HISTORY: Ohio Northern has won the last seven matchups in this series, with three of those coming by 10 points or less. The Cards dropped a 45-35 shootout last season in Ada, scoring a pair of TD's in the final three minutes to shrink the final gap.

HIGHEST HONOR: Senior linebacker Jacob Tiell was selected to wear No. 5 this season and carry on the memory of Josh Worthington, a former QB who was tragically killed in a 2004 car accident after his vehicle was struck by a drunk driver. Tiell is a returning All-OAC pick that carries a near-perfect GPA in biology.

BACK IT UP: The linebacker position for Otterbein is perhaps the deepest spot on the field, featuring talent at all class levels. Tiell, fellow seniors Derrick O'Conner and Conner Buchanan, junior Greg Nolder, sophomores Ethan Tackett and Colton Doup, and a handful of freshman have the group packing depth.

HARD TO HANDLE: Former second team All-American safety Fred Hardgrove, who also earned OAC Defensive Back of the Year honors in 2017, has returned for one final season after a roundabout career. The 27-year old Columbus product, who originally arrived as a quarterback, erupted to lead the conference in tackles (99) and interceptions (7) that fall. Keep your eyes open, because he just might do a bit of everything this time around.

LEADERS UP FRONT: In addition to the linebacking trio, offensive lineman Zack Martin and Josh Davis has also been selected to serve as team captains. Davis is a program veteran with close to 25 games played, while Martin started seven last year as a newcomer.

COACH DOUP COMMENTS:

On finally being back:

"It's been a long time. With us flipping from recruiting in the fall to playing in the spring, it's been different for us. But the excitement is there of putting pads on and having fun. We are playing football again."

On staying healthy:

"It's taken us awhile to get them physically ready, because they didn't get to bang in the fall. The challenge will be staying healthy and avoiding COVID because our roster is a bit thinner, but everyone's roster seems to be down a bit."

On playing a five-game schedule:

"I think it's a good remedy of what we're trying to do. I don't think there's any way you could play 10 games and have your kids ready to play again in August. With out division... Ohio Northern and Heidelberg have typically been up there, Wilmington's getting better and Capital has a new coach. It should be interesting."

On assessing the QB position:

"We'll end up with somebody and name a starter. I think it's important to do that. I don't like rotating, because a quarterback has to get in a flow. You can't leave a doubt in their mind."
