HAPPY ANNIVERSARY: It has now been 30 years since Otterbein and Heidelberg played the first college football game on German soil back in 1992... ending with a 7-7 tie in Frankfurt. The two programs have been competing for the Rhine River Cup ever since, and Heidelberg currently owns a narrow 15-14-1 advantage.

RECENT HISTORY: The Student Princes have won the last five matchups, including a 52-19 victory last year in Tiffin. The Cardinals last hoisted the Cup in 2016 after hanging on down the stretch for an exciting 45-38 decision. Hunter Joseph had 221 receiving yards.

AYE AYE CAPTAIN: As opposed to the usual 4-5 team captains in previous seasons, the Cardinals ended up going with eight this time around after player voting was extremely balanced. The group of Colton Doup, Zack Martin, Siraj Muhammad, Chase Carpenter, Carlos Alamo, Nick Cipriano, Tyler Wilkerson and Stephen Schmitt will rotate coin tosses throughout this fall.

BISHOPS IN CHECK: Otterbein kept the Ohio Wesleyan Battling Bishops in check after halftime last week, holding the host team scoreless en route to a 21-13 victory. The Cardinal defense bent at times but never broke, forcing a missed field goal and then making four-straight stops following 1st and Goal near the end.

MUHAMMAD GOLLY: Senior running back Siraj Muhammad had his way in the season debut, carrying the load 22 times for 149 yards and a pair of touchdowns (one in each half). He also caught two passes and helped the Cards dominate time of possession...

POSSESSION IS 9/10 OF THE LAW: Speaking of having the ball, Muhammad and the ground game (Ahjay Cody, Jordan Bost-Floyd, etc.) helped Otterbein keep possession for nearly 38 minutes at OWU. Two of the three scoring drives featured double-digit plays.

BIG UGLIES: Leading that charge during opening week was a veteran offensive line that boasts four seniors and a sophomore... all of which are returning starters from a year ago. The unit also received a nice boost from emerging youngster Cael Dent (6-foot-3, 310 pounds) in jumbo sets.

ZACH ATTACK: Sophomore linebacker Zach Hymer, making his first-career start, led Otterbein with nine tackles (four solo) to pace the Cardinal defense at OWU. He also had a quarterback hurry and will look to continue his surge from the inside.

ELIMINATE THE BIG PLAY: The scoring plays for Ohio Wesleyan last week came from 88 and 55 yards out, respectively. Those broken sequences accounted for over 40% of the Bishops' total offense. Otterbein's defense will certainly need to limit those momentum swings against a Heidelberg team known for big plays over the top.

OPPONENT OBSERVATIONS: Heidelberg remains 24th in the D3Football.com national poll after shutting out Adrian College (31-0) under the lights in Week 1. The Student Princes, led by charismatic head coach Scott Donaldson, had two scoring drives of just three plays and added an 88-yard interception return as a punctuation mark courtesy of Easton St. Clair.

VETERAN BUNCH: Heidelberg features a whopping nine graduate students as starters on the depth chart, along with another 10 true seniors listed atop the two deep at their respective positions. That would mark a combined 19 fourth or fifth-year players leading the way for a program that's gone 12-3 over the past two (one and a half) seasons.
