WELCOME BACK: This game is part of multiple festivities on campus as part of Homecoming Weekend, as we are glad to see many former Cardinals back in town. A special congrats to the Class of 1973, celebrating its 50th anniversary!

LAST MEETING: Wilmington somehow won a 32-26 game last year on its home field, despite Otterbein leading 20-7 at intermission and getting across midfield another six times in the second half. Eason Hardouin through for a career-high 361 yards while Christian Pataky had six grabs for 97 yards.

BART SHOW: Junior edge rusher Justin Bartlett is your reigning OAC Defensive Player of the Week after filling up the stat sheet against Muskingum. He had 12 tackles (four TFL's), two sacks, broke up a pass and even recovered an onside kick.

HOR-ACE IN THE HOLE: Freshman QB Lorenzen Horace provided Otterbein a nice spark last week, going for 183 total yards and two touchdowns in the fourth quarter alone. He threw for 153 and picked up another 30 with his legs, helping the Cards fly back within striking distance late. The west-coast product was recruited all the way from Stockton, Calif.

BEND BUT DON'T BREAK: Opponents have scored a touchdown on just 4 of 11 trips inside the red zone this year against the Cards. Five of those occurrences have resulted in NO points, including a Rashaun Broomfield interception last week inside the 5-yard line.

HIT THE SACK: Otterbein had five sacks defensively last week against the Muskies. In addition to Bartlett, Earlonte "Duke" Cousins tallied a pair early while Zach Hymer picked up his second this year as well. The Cards had 10 tackles for loss in the game as a whole.

PHILLY SPECIAL: Wilmington head coach Corey Fillipovich, known to many as "Filli," is in his third year overseeing the Quakers. He was named acting head coach midway through the 2021 campaign, and then improved the program's win total last year after the tag was removed. Filli was Wilmington's defensive/academic coordinator prior to that, landing OAC Assistant Coach of the Year honors during the unconventional spring season in 2021.

MR. JONES AND ME: Quaker wide receiver Lathan Jones already has six touchdowns this season, and gave Otterbein all it could handle last year by racking up 204 yards. He was subsequently named OAC Offensive Player of the Week.
