COACH WINTERS BASKETBALL CAMP AT OTTERBEIN UNIVERSITY

ANDY WINTERS - DIRECTOR OF THE CARDINAL BASKETBALL CAMP

Head men's basketball coach and Columbus native, Andy Winters, is beginning his sixth year leading the Otterbein Cardinals and the legendary Otterbein basketball program. Coach Winters transitioned to Otterbein after spending five years as the lead assistant at nearby Ohio Athletic Conference rival Capital University, where he also earned a Master's degree in Business Administration. Before Capital, he served one year as an assistant at Division II Ohio Dominican University. He also spent the 2015-16 season as the interim head coach, and the NCAA's youngest head basketball coach. Upon Coach Winters' arrival, Otterbein experienced a huge turnaround campaign during 2021-22, posting a 17-8 record to mark the most single-season victories for the program in over 15 years. Six of those losses were to teams ranked in the national poll at one point, with the Cards going an impressive 9-3 in games decided by two possessions or less. As a four-year starter at point guard for Ohio Wesleyan University, Winters was a 3X All-North Coast Athletic Conference selection, a member of the NCAC All-Decade Team, he broke all of OWU's assist records, participated in the NABC All-Star Game, and ended his senior season with First Team All-American honors. He was also voted the NCAC Player of the Year and the Regional Player of the Year by the NABC, D3Hoops.com, and D3 News after ranking top-five nationally in assists. Winters, now preparing for his tenth year as a college basketball coach, eagerly strives for greatness on and off the court in continuing Otterbein's historic success.

The Otterbein Basketball Camp is designed to assist young athletes in fulfilling their potential in an enriching, educational and enjoyable environment. The camp staff consists of top college and high school coaches from Ohio, as well as current Otterbein University players and the entire Otterbein basketball staff. Each camper competes and learns with others of the same age and abilities. Our coaches will bring out the best in each camper both on and off the court in a fun, unique setting.
