

MATCH PREVIEW:

Otterbein and Mount Union square off for a chance to play in the 2019 Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) Tournament championship game, something the Cardinals have not clinched since 2017 while the Raiders have never won the tournament, despite playing in it 11 times. The Cards are in search of their seventh championship in league tournament play. The two teams last met on Oct. 5 in Westerville as Mount Union escaped with a 2-0 victory inside Memorial Stadium, thanks to a pair of goals from Josh Lewis. Since then the Cards have added to their winning ways, now at 12-6 on the season, winning four of their last five games.

The Cardinals enter tonight with the third ranked goalie in goals allowed, giving up just 13 in OAC regular season action. Senior Collin Hoffmann also sits second in save percentage with an impressive .829 mark. Offensively, the Cards have been paced by freshman standout Gabe Sharrock, scoring 7 goals this season, while chipping in 3 assists for a total of 17 points. Otterbein earned the second seed in the tournament after a thrilling 2-1 OT victory over rival Capital last Saturday, along with an ONU loss to the Purple Raiders. Paul Hensley played the hero role for the Cards Saturday, scoring just 44 seconds into OT on a cross from Will Isaac. The Cards are 8-1 at home this season, the lone loss to Mount Union, while only allowing 6 goals inside of Memorial Stadium this season.

The Raiders come into play following a wild 2-2 draw after 110 minutes of action at fourth-seeded Capital this past Tuesday afternoon, a game which saw Mount Union advance to the tournament semifinals following a 5-4 triumph in penalty kicks. Mount Union goalie Zach Hlas has been a staple of Mount Unions success this season, posting an impressive 0.67 goals-against-average to go along with his third ranked save percentage of .800, trailing only Cardinal goalie Hoffmann, and John Carroll keeper Connor Robinson (.850).

Tonights winner will advance to play in the Championship game of the OAC Tournament, to be held at the highest remaining seed.
