MATCH PREVIEW:

Otterbein and Baldwin Wallace square off in a crticial conference matchup that could hold big implications down the line within the standings.

The Cardinals return home following a month-long stretch away from home in September, where the team played 16 matches on someone else's court. Otterbein has found its stride, however, with a 10-match winning streak and winning the last five in straight sets.

The Cards are receiving contributions from multiple players on the floor, headlined by the senior All-American duo of outside hitter Hadley Sterett and setter Andrea Miller. Sterett leads the OAC and ranks top-10 nationally in kills per set (4.37) while Miller is also amongst the top-10 in the country for assists (11/set).

BW is in the midst of a 19-match winning streak itself and had a big-time victory earlier this week, taking down No. 17-ranked Ohio Northern in Berea by scores of 25-21, 26-24, 25-16. The Yellow Jackets went 23-0 in the non-conference last year before a 4-5 mark within the league and finishing sixth.

Senior Alicia Lortcher has been a staple in the BW lineup and is averaging 2.35 kills per set in her final campaign. Ashley Nuding and Kathleen Egan form a 1-2 punch at the setter position with just over a combined 11 helpers per set.

Otterbein emerged in four sets last season when the teams met up in Berea, prevailing by final counts of 21-25, 25-18, 25-23, 26-24.
